The Concerto Competition offers students the opportunity to perform up to an entire Concerto with the VIMA Senior Orchestra, conducted by Maestro David Bui, at the closing concert of the Academy on August 14, 2026. The Competition is divided into two rounds, and each VIMA Faculty member will serve as a judge. There will be two grand prize winners from the Senior and Junior Strings category, and two from the Senior and Junior Piano category. Certificates and prizes will be presented in the Awards Ceremony at the conclusion of the Final Round.

Please note: the repertoire list below is applicable to both Junior and Senior division competitors. The selection of repertoire is entirely at the discretion of each student. Students are free to choose any repertoire piece regardless of the age group they are registered in.

New for the 2026 season: The Concerto Competition will introduce a new category for young musicians aged 8 and under, the **Piccolo Musicians** category. This category will provide a supportive environment for these young musicians to showcase their talent and foster their musical growth and development. Participants of the Piccolo Musicians category will have the opportunity to perform one piece of their own choice, with a maximum duration of 10 minutes. The winner of the Piccolo Musicians category will be invited to perform a solo piece at the closing concert of the Academy on August 14, 2026.
